Safeguarding Policy Statement

In accordance with the Diocese in Europe's Safeguarding Policy, our Chaplaincy is committed to:

- Promoting a safer environment and culture.
- vulnerable adults within the church. Safely recruiting and supporting all those with any responsibility related to children, young people and
- Responding promptly to every safeguarding concern or allegation.
- Caring pastorally for victims/survivors of abuse and other affected persons
- Caring pastorally for those who are the subject of concerns or allegations of abuse and other affected
- Responding to those that may pose a present risk to others.

The Chaplaincy will:

- Endeavour to create a safe and caring place for all.
- implement policy and procedures. Have a named local Safeguarding Officer to work with the incumbent and the Chaplaincy Council to
- Safely recruit, train and support all those with any responsibility for children, young people and vulnerable adults tohave the confidence and skills to recognise and respond to abuse
- Where possible, ensure that there is appropriate insurance cover for all activities involving children and vulnerable adults undertaken in the name of the chaplaincy.
- safeguarding concerns or support needs. Display in church premises and on the chaplaincy website the details of who to contact if there are
- Listen to and take seriously all those who disclose abuse.
- local child and/or adult services immediately. following House of Bishops' guidance, including notifying the Diocesan Safeguarding Adviser (DSA) and Take steps to protect children and vulnerable adults when a safeguarding concern of any kind arises,
- Offer support to victims/survivors of abuse regardless of the type of abuse, when or where it occurred.
- vulnerable adults, whilst maintaining appropriate confidentiality and the safety of all parties. Care for and monitor any member of the church community who may pose a risk to children and
- Review the implementation of the Safeguarding Policy, procedures and practices at least annually.
